WHAT WE DO

In Central Texas more than 1,300 children were confirmed victims of child abuse last year. These children need intervention and hope to begin a path to healing.

The CACCT provides:

- A safe place that offers a child friendly, comfortable environment where specialized forensic interviewers talk to children and help investigators determine whether or not abuse has occurred.
- A safe place where law enforcement, prosecutors and child protective service workers can collaborate child abuse investigations in a manner sensitive to the needs of young victims and create positive outcomes.
- A safe place where child abuse victims and their families receive counseling, sexual assault exams, and family advocacy services that provide hope, healing and gives them back their childhood.

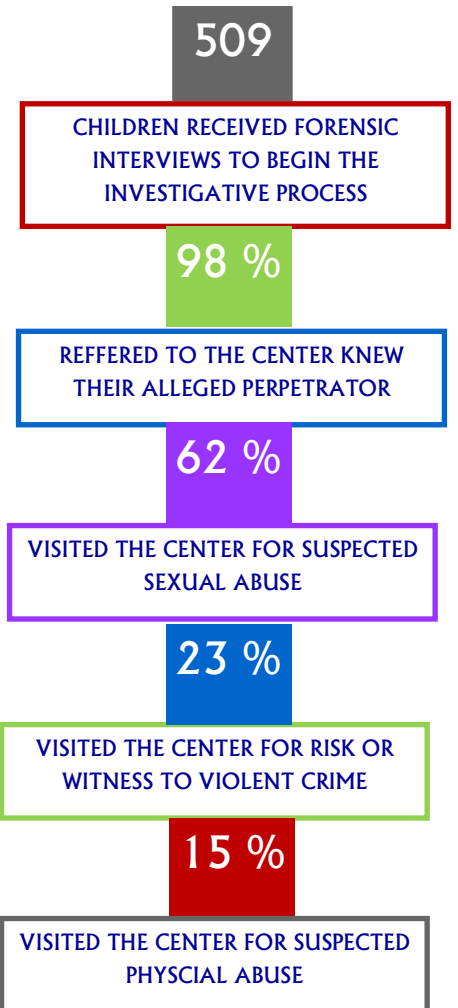
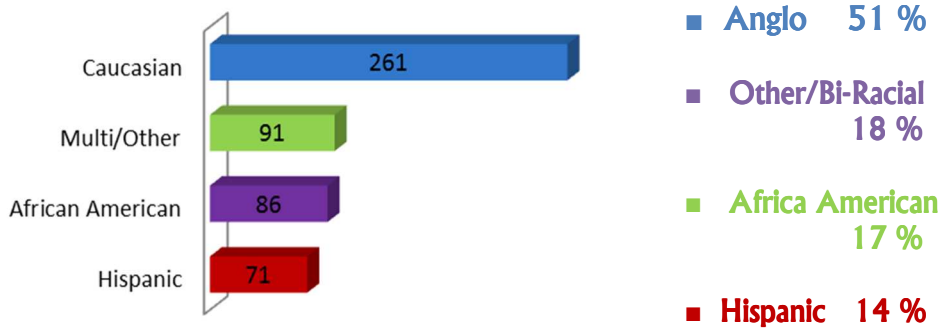
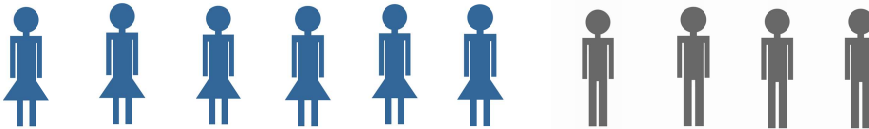


509 children received 1,685 services such as crisis intervention, forensic interviews, case coordination, case management and counseling.

BOYS 35 %

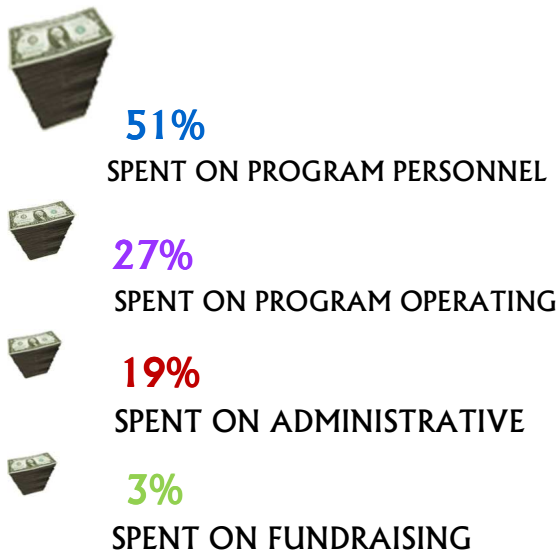


THE CENTER ALSO PROVIDED THERAPY AND FAMILY ADVOCACY SERVICES
